

- All cancellations received after September 1, 2023, will be subject to an administration fee of \$250.
- If notice of the cancellation is received after September 19, 2023, 100% of the registration and the guest pass fees will be non refundable.
- Registration can be transferred at no extra cost (member to member, non-member to non-member).
