RCMP Parade, Depot, and Heritage Centre



RCMP members are born all over the world, but they are made in Regina, Saskatchewan at the RCMP Training Academy “Depot” Division. Enjoy a guided trolley tour of the grounds where they have been training the best and brightest since 1885.

Catch the Sergeant Major's Parade and watch as the drill staff put Cadets through their paces accompanied by the Cadet band.

On the front lawn of this historic training facility, is the majestic RCMP Heritage Centre. This museum brings to life one of Canada's oldest and most iconic stories, the story of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The Heritage Centre is architecturally fascinating, designed by Canadian architect Arthur Erickson who is also known for BC Place among other buildings.

Also inside the RCMP Heritage Centre is the SGI Canada Theatre where you will be able to watch a 22 minute movie about the training a Cadet goes through to join the RCMP. The movie runs every half hour and the theatre accommodates up to 125 people.

Bushwakker Brewing Company Ltd.



Enjoy a local brewery tour including an exclusive beer tasting and appetizers at Saskatchewan's award-winning Bushwakker Brewpub! Bushwakker brews 12 year-round beers, over 25 seasonal beers, as well as their famous Blackberry Mead which is released on the first Saturday of every December. The brewery has undergone a number of expansions since 1991 to meet the growing demand. Bushwakker beers have taken home 21 national awards and three international awards. They focus on traditional Lager and Ale styles but enjoy getting creative with their rotating fruit beers and specialty casks. Being a brewpub and not a microbrewery, most of their beer is sold for in-house consumption and in their offsale cooler at the end of the bar. Quality – not quantity!

A. RCMP & Bushwakker with Bus Transportation

Cost: \$45 +GST. Please pre-register as part of your conference registration. Space is limited.

Itinerary:

11:45am – Bus departs from Hotel Saskatchewan.

12:00pm – Bus arrives at RCMP. Enter RCMP Heritage Centre to meet the tour guide and receive identification tags. As the trolley tour is outdoors, please dress accordingly. In the case of inclement weather, seating is provided in the Drill Hall.

2:15pm – Bus departs from RCMP.

2:30pm – Bus arrives at Bushwakker for brewery tour, beer tasting, and appetizers.

4:30pm – Bus departs from Bushwakker and returns to Hotel Saskatchewan.

B. RCMP Only – Own Transportation

Cost: \$10 +GST. Please pre-register as part of your conference registration. Space is limited on the trolley tour.

Directions:

- **Drive West** on Dewdney Avenue (past Lewvan Drive).
- Go over small bridge.
- **Take first left** after small bridge (onto Bonner Drive). The large sloped building covered in windows and pillars is the RCMP Heritage Centre.
- **Take first right** into the parking lot (there is plenty of free parking).
- Walk into the RCMP Heritage Centre.
- Meet up with the bus group and receive identification tags.
- As the trolley tour is outdoors, please dress accordingly. In the case of inclement weather, seating is provided in the Drill Hall.

C. Bushwakker Only – Own Transportation
